

## **JSANDS website Content and Privacy Policy (www.jsands.jo)**

### **Privacy policy**

This content and privacy policy ("Policy") describes how Website Operator ("Website Operator", "we", "us" or "our") collects, protects and uses the personally identifiable information ("Personal Information") you ("User", "you" or "your") may provide on the jsands.jo website and any of its products or services (collectively, "Website" or "Services").

It also describes the choices available to you regarding our use of your Personal Information and how you can access and update this information. This Policy does not apply to the practices of companies that we do not own or control, or to individuals that we do not employ or manage.

It also describes the commitment regarding the information published in the website.

### **Website Contents commitments:**

The JSANDS website is committed to providing objective and trustworthy up-to-date information and scientific evidence on all aspects of neonatal and stillbirths' health care.

The JSANDS website is committed to the highest editorial and ethical standards in the provision of all its content and scientific related materials. The content, data and information on the website are commissioned by Jordan University of Science and Technology (JUST) and delivered by JSANDS team. This covers all contents including written articles, video and audio resources, interactive tools, infographics, images and links.

#### **A. Appropriateness of Content**

Before any work is proposed to create new content, the proposed content is subject to the following: Is there a clear user need and supporting evidence? Also, does it fit with the JSANDS main goal and objectives?

Once a piece of content has been drafted, it is edited by a senior member of The JSANDS team or technical committee. It is checked for accuracy, appropriateness, and tone.

All content on the JSANDS website will be suitable for a general audience and will not include material that might reasonably be deemed offensive. Where content includes explicit sensitive information it will be clearly flagged.

**B. Individual content items**

The JSANDS website hosts some individual content items (i.e. videos, audios) designed by the JSANDS team. These products are verified to ensure they comply with the JSANDS policies and standards, effectively going through the editing review process before being approved for publication.

**C. Scientific research paper**

The research papers that published on the JSANDS website is derived from peer-reviewed scientific research papers. These scientific papers are fallen into two categories: JSANDS publication and relevant publications. JSANDS publication contains all scientific research papers that have been published by the JSANDS team using data from the JSANDS surveillance system. Relevant publications section contains scientific papers about neonatal and stillbirths research conducted in Jordan and worldwide. These papers are checked with respect to its quality.

**D. JSANDS member interests**

The JSANDS website has a dedicated team that has a clear vision to provide accurate and transparent information on all aspects of neonatal and stillbirths healthcare. However, no member of the JSANDS team can be asked, and it is not permitted, to provide favored healthcare services or treatment to any audience.

**Data Governance (for the website)**

The JSANDS team and the technical committee review, advise and approve all content published on the JSANDS website. They have the responsibility in assuring the quality of relevant information on the website. They manage the selection and presentation of published information.

**Automatic collection of information**

Our top priority is customer data security and, as such, we exercise the no logs policy. We process only minimal user data, only as much as it is absolutely necessary to maintain the Website or Services. Information collected automatically is used only to identify potential cases of abuse and establish statistical information regarding Website usage. This statistical information is not otherwise aggregated in such a way that would identify any particular user of the system.

We do not collect or store any personal data on the JSANDS website. Also, when browsing, reading pages or downloading information from the website directly or via application mobile interfaces APIs, no any information about your visit is collected or stored.

### **Collection of personal information**

You can visit the Website without telling us who you are or revealing any information by which someone could identify you as a specific, identifiable individual. If, however, you wish to use some of the Website's features, you will be asked to provide certain Personal Information (for example, your name and e-mail address). We receive and store any information you knowingly provide to us when you fill any online forms on the Website. You can choose not to provide us with your Personal Information, but then you may not be able to take advantage of some of the Website's features. Users who are uncertain about what information is mandatory are welcome to contact us.

### **Storing, Using or processing personal information**

We don't collect or store or process any personal information for any user.

### **Privacy of children**

We do not knowingly collect any Personal Information from children under the age of 13. If you are under the age of 13, please do not submit any Personal Information through our Website or Service. We encourage parents and legal guardians to monitor their children's Internet usage and to help enforce this Policy by instructing their children never to provide Personal Information through our Website or Service without their permission.

If you have reason to believe that a child under the age of 13 has provided Personal Information to us through our Website or Service, please contact us. ### **Do Not Track signals**

### **Information security**

We secure information you provide on computer servers in a controlled, secure environment, protected from unauthorized access, use, or disclosure. We maintain reasonable administrative, technical, and physical safeguards in an effort to protect against unauthorized access, use, modification, and disclosure of Personal Information in its control and custody. However, no data transmission over the Internet or wireless network can be guaranteed. Therefore, while we strive to protect your Personal Information, you acknowledge that (i) there are security and privacy limitations of the Internet which are beyond our control; (ii) the security, integrity, and privacy of any and all information and data exchanged between you and our Website cannot be guaranteed; and (iii) any such information and data may be viewed or tampered with in transit by a third-party, despite best efforts.

### **Data breach**

In the event we become aware that the security of the Website has been compromised or users Personal Information has been disclosed to unrelated third parties as a result of external activity, including, but not limited to, security attacks or fraud, we reserve the right to take reasonably appropriate measures, including, but not limited to, investigation and reporting, as well as notification to and cooperation with law enforcement authorities. In the event of a data breach, we will make reasonable efforts to notify affected individuals if we believe that there is a reasonable risk of harm to the user as a result of the breach or if notice is otherwise required by law. When we do, we will post a notice on the Website.

### **Changes and amendments**

We may update this Privacy Policy from time to time in our discretion and will notify you of any material changes to the way in which we treat Personal Information. When changes are made, we will revise the updated date at the bottom of this page. We may also provide notice to you in other ways in our discretion, such as through contact information you have provided. Any updated version of this Privacy Policy will be effective immediately upon the posting of the revised Privacy Policy unless otherwise specified. Your continued use of the Website or Services after the effective date of the revised Privacy Policy (or such other act specified at that time) will constitute your consent to those changes. However, we will not, without your consent, use your Personal Data in a manner materially different than what was stated at the time your Personal Data was collected.
